Just a few reminders for the term ahead:

We will be visiting the school library on a Thursday afternoon. The children will be able to choose a book to bring home to share. Once they have read the book please return it school and it can be changed on their following visit.

Please remember to upload any family adventures or super learning that your child demonstrates at home onto their Tapestry account. We share everything you upload with the children on Tuesday afternoons during our 'Tapestry Tuesdays' time. The children love to see themselves on the screen and to share their home lives with their friends.

If anyone different is picking up your child from school, please let a member of the Foundation Team know. We will then record this on our board so that all adults are aware.
