MATHS

How can you help at home?



- Help your child to recognise all notes and coins and to find totals with these.
- Understand the pairs of numbers that add to total 20 and their inverse (E.g. $17+3=20$ $20-3=17$ $20-17=3$)
- Count in 2s 3s 5s and 10s up to 100.
- Tell the time to quarter past and half past the hour.

Our theme this term is: **Changing Homes, Changing Times.**

Our Big Question is: How can we be agents of change?

In History we will learn about how our homes have changed over time and discover key changes in our daily lives e.g. home entertainment and smart phones and consider whether all change is positive. In Art we will learn how we can be agents of change and use our art to convey positive messages; we will look at activism in art through some of the works of Banksy. In D.T we will learn how to repurpose recycled materials and in Science we will learn about materials and their properties. Throughout the term we will consider our 'Big Question' about how we can make change for good and be 'agents of change'!

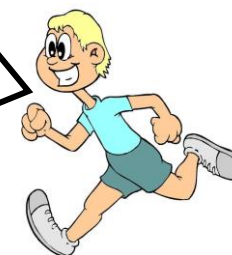
