### MATHS

**Measures- Length & Perimeter:** Measure in km and m. Equivalent lengths. Perimeter of shapes.

**Number – Fractions:** Mixed numbers, compare and order numbers. Improper / equivalent fractions.

**Number - Multiplication & Division B:** Multiply and divide by 10 and 100. Multiplication and division methods.

**Number – Decimals A:** Finding tenths / hundredths. Fractions. Dividing by 10 and 100.
