Thank you for all of your support with the homework that is sent each week. Keep practising the times tables as the National expectation by the end of Year 4 is for instant recollection up to their 12 times table. Once these are known, they provide a super boost in confidence for the children. There will be the first statutory National Multiplication Tables Check after half-term, whereby the children will need to answer 25 random multiplication questions, within six seconds for each answer.

Furthermore, a minimum of 20 minutes of reading should be completed every night. Please encourage your children to do this. Reading books are changed every Friday and the children will have the opportunity of choosing their own books to take home.

It is essential that the appropriate labelled PE kit and outdoor shoes are worn on our PE days, which will continue to be Monday and Wednesday.
