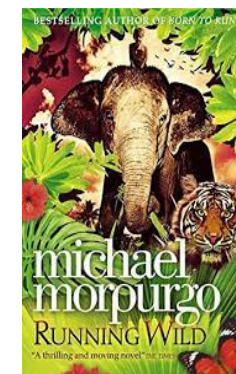

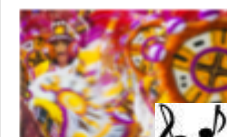
Units of study: E-safety, search technologies, combining software for presentation and word processing. Children will build upon skills in coding algorithms using code.org.
