## OPTIONAL ART COMPETITION FOR ALL

As many of you may already know, St Andrew's CE Primary has a long history of donating and raising the profile for the good work the Skekinah charity does for the homeless, especially in Plymouth itself. This year, they have invited our school to enter an art competition to help them celebrate their 30<sup>th</sup> year of fundraising.

They would like our pupils to create some artwork using the theme of 'homelessness'. The top 3 designs will then be put forward by the school to be exhibited with other schools in the city for judging. The winning design will then be auctioned at a Celebration Dinner on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2022. (see poster below)

Our pupils will have until Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March to complete their piece of artwork, which will need to be handed to their class teacher ready for judging. The artwork preferably needs to be two dimensional, no smaller than A4 and no bigger than A2, however this can be any medium; paint, pastel, pencil, collage, textile - the choice is yours! Be creative, fill the space to express the message of 'homelessness'.

Once an art studio venue is confirmed, the exhibit will be open to public viewing where parents and pupils can view all the chosen shortlisted designs. The public may also have the opportunity to buy some of the artwork if they wish to, with all the proceeds going to Shekinah. Good luck!
