Further work will be carried out on the redevelopment project for the local community and a range of poetry will be explored linked to the project and our Steam train trip to Paignton.


SPELLING


Spelling assessments will take place every Wednesday and involved 10 new spellings following a pattern and 5 previously learnt spellings.
