Number- decimals: multiply/divide decimals by integers, convert fractions to decimals.

Number - algebra: form expressions, one/two step rules, solving equations.

Measurements - perimeter, area & volume: area and perimeter, area of triangles/parallelograms, volume of cuboids.

Number - ratio: links between ratio and fractions, scale factors, ratio and proportion problems.



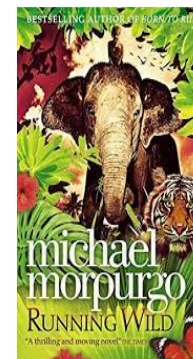
ENGLISH

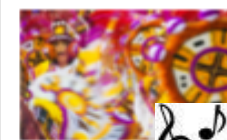
