Number - Fractions : add or subtract fractions & find fractions of quantities

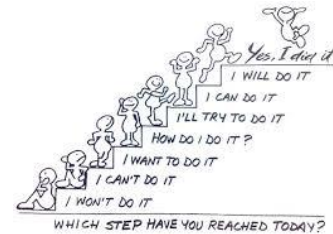
Geometry - Shape: angles, parallel or perpendicular, recognise & describe properties of 2D/3D shapes
