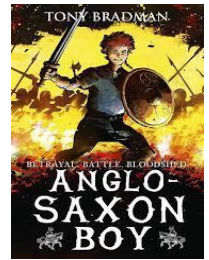


ST ANDREW'S C of E PRIMARY SCHOOL

MATHS

Number- Place Value: Numbers to 1000, comparing & ordering numbers, more or less, counting in multiples including 50.

Number - Addition & Subtraction: Add & subtract multiples, add and subtract 3 digit & 1 or digit numbers crossing boundaries, add or subtract two 2 digit numbers.

Number - Multiplication & Division: Multiplication using arrays, multiply or divide by 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 or 10, make equal groups by sharing or grouping in a variety of ways.

Length & Perimeter: Measure in mm, cm & m, add & subtract lengths, calculate & measure perimeter.

Theme: People on the Move!

Big Question: Why did people go on journeys? What does migration look like in modern times?
