Measurements – Time: converting analogue and digital times, converting to and from the 24- hour clock.

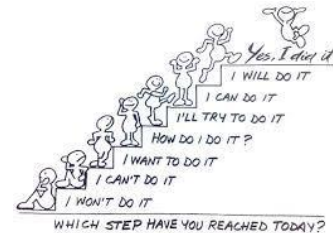
Geometry – Shape: angles, shape names, symmetry.
