MATHS

We follow the White Rose scheme of work:

Number- Place Value: Numbers to 1000, comparing & ordering numbers, more or less, counting in multiples including 50.

Number - Addition & Subtraction: Add & subtract multiples, add and subtract 3 digit & 1 or digit numbers crossing boundaries, add or subtract two 2 digit numbers.

Number - Multiplication & Division: Multiplication using arrays, multiply or divide by 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 or 10, make equal groups by sharing or grouping in a variety of ways.

Theme: Back to the Stone Age!

- 20 minutes of reading per day
- Weekly spellings
- Times Tables (Challenge 21 facts)
