Back To The Stone Age

SCIENCE:

Rocks / waterproof materials.

Stone Age cave art, jewellery, tools, weapons, food.

MUSIC: Miss Smith will be teaching percussion for one hour per week

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

What do Hindus believe God is like? What is the 'Trinity' and why is it important for Christians?

MFL-FRENCH: Greetings/Getting to know you & feelings and All about me.

COMPUTING:

The Internet / Understanding Networks including evaluating online content; Audio Production – producing and editing podcasts.

Number - Place Value: Numbers to 1000, comparing & ordering numbers, more or less, counting in multiples including 50.

Number - Addition & Subtraction: Add & subtract multiples, add and subtract 3 digit & 1 or digit numbers crossing boundaries, add or subtract two 2 digit numbers.

Measurement – Area: Comparing area / making shapes.

Number - Multiplication & Division A: Multiplication using arrays, multiply or divide by 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 or 10, make equal groups by sharing or grouping in a variety of ways.

HOMEWORK:

Times tables / division facts: On-going weekly practice, regular use of Mathletics and Times Tables Rockstars online practice - tested every Monday.

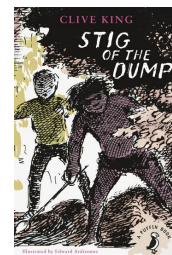
Spellings: Regular use of Spelling Shed - tested every Wednesday.
