MATHS

We will cover:

Place Value: To Recognise, Compare and Order to 1 million, Rounding to nearest 10,100,1000,10000 and 100000, to recognise Roman Numerals.

Addition and Subtraction: Add and Subtract with more than 4 digits (formal column method), use Rounding to estimate and Solve Multi-step +/- Problems.

Multiplications and Division: Multiples, Factors, Common factors, Prime numbers, Square & Cube Numbers, to Multiply and Divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

Fractions: Recognise and Find Equivalent Fractions, Convert between Improper and Mixed number fractions, Compare/Order Fractions, Add and Subtract Fractions.



HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD?

Year 5 is an important year in your child's education setting them up for the Key Stage 2 SATs in Year 6 and their journey into secondary school. Please help them get into a good routine with learning spellings, reading their book and completing Mathematics tasks.
